HEALTH/IMMUNIZATIONS

The charges for each test may range from \$20.00 to \$100.00 depending upon the healthcare provider and the student's health insurance status.

The following immunizations are required prior to practicum at clinical sites. Students will need to submit proof of vaccination or a titer result demonstrating immunity to the following:

• Varicella, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Hepatitis B, TDAP

For Hepatitis B series the student needs proof of vaccination OR proof of beginning series OR titer demonstrating immunity

• Two-step TB skin test

CPR

Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers CPR certification through American Heart Association or American Red Cross is required. Student may register for NAS115 at the College, or seek certification elsewhere. Certification cost depend upon the provider, and may range from \$55 to \$100.

UNIFORMS

Student emblem (patch), one for each uniform set (available at online College bookstore)

Galaxy blue scrub tops and bottoms, two sets recommended. Price range from \$25 and up.

White shoes – healthcare or walking shoes. Price varies.

Name Badge (see example) – price ranges from \$10 and up.
