



Modified Financial Aid Information for Prospective or New Students Updated 3/31/20

Drake State is currently accepting applications for the 2020 Summer semester.

Prospective or new students:

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online (www.studentaid.gov).
- It is highly recommended that you use IRS Data Retrieval tool.
 - In the finances section of the online FAFSA form, you will see a “Link to IRS” button if you are eligible to use the IRS DRT.
 - Click the “Link to IRS” button and log in with your FSA ID to be transferred to the IRS to retrieve your info.
- Be sure to create a Federal Student Aid ID online at www.studentaid.gov during the application process.
- Drake State’s school code for the FAFSA is **005260**.
- If applying for Summer 2020 semester complete the 2019-2020 FAFSA utilizing your 2017 tax information.
- If applying for the Fall 2020 semester, submit the 2020-2021 FAFSA utilizing your 2018 tax information.
